General customer information about RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU ("RoHS 2.0") and extension of restricted substances by Directive 2015/863 ("RoHS 3.0")

All SICK products are developed and manufactured according to the applicable regulations. Since 2006, SICK has been developing all new products in a fully RoHS-compliant manner and has therefore been actively promoting the transition to RoHS conformity since its early stages.

The transition of all SICK products that fall within the scope of the RoHS Directive has been completed by the mandatory deadline of July 22, 2017. Consequently, none of the products that we deliver to you contain, to the best of our knowledge, any substances which may not be placed on the market pursuant to the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU.

SICK products are classified either as Category 3 (IT and telecommunications equipment) or as Category 9 (industrial monitoring and control instruments). As of July 22, 2017 conformity of those products is declared, pursuant to article 7 c) of the RoHS Directive, by means of the EU Declaration of Conformity.


In some exceptional cases, the scope of the RoHS Directive excludes SICK products in accordance with Article 2 (4). In these cases, the EU Declaration of Conformity does not include the RoHS Directive.

It is not permitted to confirm RoHS compliance of electronic components or other accessories that do not fall within the scope of the RoHS Directive by means of the EU Declaration of Conformity. Nevertheless, we can provide the RoHS-status of these products to you upon request.

The European Commission has agreed to amend the EU-RoHS-Directive (2011/65/EU) by adding four additional restricted substances according to the Directive 2015/863/EU: Di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (**DEHP**), Butylbenzylphthalate (**BBP**), Dibutylphthalate (**DBP**), Diisobutylphthalate (**DIBP**).

The new restrictions apply to **Category 3 Products** ((IT and telecommunications equipment) as of **July 22**, **2019** and to **Category 9 Products** (industrial monitoring and control instruments) as of **July 22**, **2021**. In order to comply with the new restrictions and the Directive 2015/863/EU by the aforementioned effective dates, we are actively working on this topic.
