Exercise tasks will be used to monitor participant's competency as the training progresses.

- Examine differences between Static and Dynamic teach-in functions

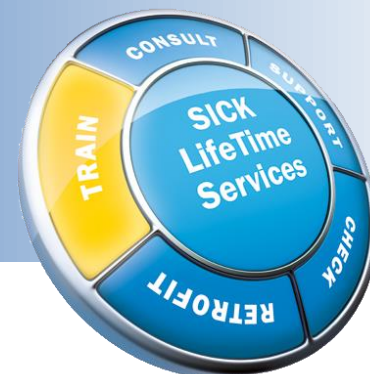
Course Benefits
